Article II. The Project

Section 2.01 Mission

By the end of this project we hope to achieve the following:

A. Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory, a residential program for 9th through 12th grade high school students will <u>NOT</u> participate in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. Foods served in school cafeteria <u>MAY</u> meet none, some, or all Nutrient Standards established by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory food service department <u>MAY</u> provide after school program snacks that meet federal nutrition guidelines.

B. Students will eat breakfast and dinner five days a week Monday through Friday. Students will eat breakfast, lunch and dinner Saturday, Sundays and Monday holidays. Students eat lunch during the school days at Flagstaff High School of the Flagstaff Unified School District, a public school system.

Section 2.02 Project Specifications

The food distribution company will deliver food supplies to Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory Board, Inc. on a regular schedule for school year: July 28, 2025 through May 22, 2026 with possible renewals for 2027 and 2028, located at 901 North Kinlani Road, Flagstaff, Arizona 86001.

Section 2.03 Contractor Requirements

Should your proposal be accepted, we expect you to contribute the following to the project:

- A. The contractor shall deliver food and products to Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory Board, Inc. for sixteen (16) healthy meals per student week for the school year 2025-2026. There are 132 high school students who reside at the dormitory. The following foods and products are needed: Breakfast Sunday through Saturday, lunch Saturday and Sunday and dinner Sunday through Saturday.
- B. The contractor will deliver food for special event and holiday meals during the school year. The annual Thanksgiving dinner is served on Wednesday, November 19, 2025. The senior class and academic achievement banquet is on or about Thursday, May 15, 2025. Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory Board, Inc. may add other special event meals during the school year.
- C. The contractor will deliver five (5) food snacks per student week for the Flagstaff Bordertown Dormitory Board, Inc. after school program.

- 4. The proposing company's past performance in delivering such services.
- 5. Availability of sufficient high quality food products with required nutrition values.
- 6. Overall costs of food and products of the proposal.
